CONSTITUTION

25 April 2001

ARTICLE I

The name of the organization shall be ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-SIXTH REGIMENTAL ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE II

The object of the association shall be to perpetuate the comradeship of members and the memory of their glorious deeds while in the military service of the United States. To support the recruiting, retention, training, organization, and reorganization of the One Hundred Twenty-Sixth Infantry Regiment and its successors, so as to keep the heritage of this auspicious organization alive.

ARTICLE III

Membership – any person who has served honorably in the One Hundred Twenty-Sixth Infantry or successor unit shall be eligible.

ARTICLE IV

The officers shall consist of: President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Sergeant at Arms, Chaplain, Historian and Assistant Historian. Election of officers shall be held at the annual meeting of the Association. An elected officer shall hold office for one year except: the office of President, which will be progressive from Second Vice President to First Vice President to President; and the Historian, Chaplain, Secretary and Treasurer, who shall remain in office as long as they are willing to serve or until they are voted out of office.

ARTICLE V

Date for the annual meeting will be selected by the Executive Committee. Meetings shall be not less than 10 months or more than 15 months from the preceding year.

ARTICLE VI

This constitution may be amended by two-thirds vote of the members present at any regular meeting; provided that the notice of the meeting has been mailed to the membership one month preceding the meeting, listing the proposed amendments.
